What is ImmTrac?

ImmTrac is a service provided by the State of Texas that stores and consolidates immunization records in one central electronic system. ImmTrac keeps all your immunization records to produce an immunization history for every phase of your life.

Benefits

You can safely store your immunization records in ImmTrac at no cost to you. Even if you got one vaccine at your doctor's office and another at your local pharmacy, you can electronically keep all your immunization records in ImmTrac. You can request a copy of your immunization history when you need it for college entrance requirements, military enlistment, travel, employment in health and safety fields, and other instances.

Your ImmTrac authorized health-care provider can access your immunization history and make sure you are not over or under vaccinated. As you receive more immunizations, they can be added to your record.

ImmTrac is:

- A no-cost service
- Secure
- Confidential
- Electronic
- Accessible to authorized health-care providers

How to register

Anyone who would like to keep immunization records in a secure and confidential electronic system can register in ImmTrac.

- 1 Download and complete the ImmTrac Adult Consent Form (F11-13366).
- 2 Gather and make copies of all your official immunization records.
- 3 Send in your completed ImmTrac Adult Consent Form and copies of your official immunization records to your authorized health-care provider, local health department, health service region office, or the Texas Department of State Health Services, ImmTrac office.

You can register in ImmTrac even if you are not up to date on your immunizations or don't know where your immunization records are. You may want to review the *Recommended Adult Immunization Schedule* with a health-care provider to determine which vaccines you may need. There are more recommended adult vaccines now than when you were a child. Go to ImmTracForEveryone.com to download the *Recommended Adult Immunization Schedule*.

If you are having trouble finding your immunization records, you may be able to get them by contacting your last known health-care provider, contacting the last school you attended, or looking in your baby book.

Request an immunization history from ImmTrac

Just like you cannot view your medical records online, you cannot view your ImmTrac records online either. This is to ensure the confidentiality and security of the immunization records. As a registered ImmTrac client, you can request a copy of your immunization history from ImmTrac by contacting your authorized health-care provider, local health department, health service region office, or the Texas Department of State Health Services, ImmTrac office.

You must complete and sign an Authorization to Release Official Immunization History form. The signed form authorizes the local health departments, health service regions, and the Texas Department of State Health Services, ImmTrac office to look up and retrieve your immunization history.

You can withdraw from ImmTrac at any time.
